## CME IN CHILD HEALTH (CCH)

## Wadia Hospital

The Bai Jerbai Wadia Hospital for Children and Research Centre is a charitable hospital catering to the health needs, primarily, of the economically underprivileged children. It is a 250 bedded pediatric hospital which has been in existence for the past 80 years. The hospital houses over 20 super specialties & provides some unique services under its roof. On the medical side, the super specialties include cardiology, endocrinology, hemato-oncology, nephrology, neurology & epilepsy. On the surgical side, it has pediatric surgery, orthopedics, plastic surgery, burns, ENT & neurosurgery. The burns department has started with a unique way of treatment wherein the children heal excellently with potato peel dressings. Special clinics are run to look after children with HIV infections, genetic diseases, liver disorders, skin diseases, and eye problems. Special diagnostic facilities offered include ECG for children. A new immunology division has also been started. The hospital has the only Dialysis services center for children, in Mumbai. The research wing of the hospital undertakes prenatal diagnosis for Thalassemia Major.

The hospital is a University recognized teaching and training centre for MD pediatrics and MCh pediatric surgery. It has a National Board post doctoral fellowship program in pediatric hemato-oncology. It is also a training center for pediatric intensive care. The hospital has served as an academic center of excellence and several pediatricians trained here are now renowned practitioners spread across the globe. In continuing with their promise to pave new paths of knowledge for the society, the Bai Jerbai Wadia Hospital for Children conducts programs for doctors since the year 2003 by the Institute of Child Health & Research Centre.
